NORFOLK, VA: With

your donations, Operation Blessing enables local churches to bring food to the hungry, assisting those who are facing difficult times.



MEXICO: Rainwater harvesting systems brought safe water home to families in Mexico. This saves them the task of fetching and carrying heavy loads of water daily.

HONDURAS: Over the last year, Operation Blessing donors like you provided baby turtles, young tilapia and tiny crustaceans to more than 500 people in a community in Honduras. These small creatures make a big difference in rural communities – they naturally feed on mosquito larvae and help prevent mosquito-borne diseases like dengue, Zika, and chikungunya.

RESTORING HOMES AND HEARTS IN KENTUCKY

KENTUCKY – Bertha had already lost her husband. Then, the unbelievable happened. She lost her home.

An elderly widow, Bertha had lived in Russellville, Kentucky, for sixty years and had accumulated many memories over the years. Then an F3 tornado threatened her community. Bertha took shelter with her daughter and hoped for the best.

"It was scary," said Bertha. "I didn't know if we'd have a house when we came back."

The two made it safely through the storm, but her fears came true. The tornado directly hit Bertha's home. It tore off the roof and blew out the windows. Water damaged the walls.

"I didn't think it could be fixed... I just thought it was gone," said Bertha, wiping the tears from her eyes. "People don't know what they got, until they lose it."





Compassionate friends like you didn't want her to face this disaster alone. When we heard about Bertha, we knew we had to help her. Teams of volunteers got right to work. We were able to fix the roof and damaged floors, replace the cabinets, and repair the walls of her house. Then you helped provide new furniture to make her house feel like a home again.

"You can't tell that anything had happened to it. It looks so nice," Bertha said. "You all have really done great wonders to this house."

Thanks to friends like you, Bertha's house was transformed. With tears, she expressed her gratitude, because together, we were able to give her hope for the future.

UKRAINE RESPONSE BRINGING HOPE TO REFUGEES IN CRISIS

When war broke out in Ukraine, millions of people fled their homes and crossed the borders of neighboring nations as refugees. Most were women and children.

Nadiya was feeding her baby when she heard that a rocket had been fired at her city. Terrified, she immediately fled the country with a suitcase and her two children.

Operation Blessing in partnership with churches and humanitarian groups welcomed Nadiya and many other refugees at the border in Poland with compassion and a safe place to sleep. Your donations provided hot food, blankets, clothing, hygiene supplies, and the support they needed to face the difficult days ahead.

"We were provided with everything we needed," said Nadiya. "We were welcomed here."

Together with friends like you, we were able to show God's love and compassion to many Ukrainian refugees just like Nadiya in their time of deepest need.

"I don't know why God loves us so much," said another young mother, unable to hold back her tears. "I have never met such overwhelming care, understanding, and attention. I am endlessly grateful."

CLEAN WATER

ALLEVIATING SUFFERING THROUGH CLEAN WATER

Being able to drink a glass of clean water is something many of us take for granted. But more and more people around the world are living in regions where access to clean water is scarce. They have no other choice but to get their water from streams or stagnant ponds that are contaminated with harmful bacteria.

According to the World Health Organization, more than 2 billion people live in water-stressed regions today and only have access to water that is dangerous for them to drink. They often get seriously sick with diarrhea and suffer from deadly illnesses like typhoid, cholera, and dysentery. Some, including children and the elderly, even die simply because they have no access to safe water.

Thanks to our generous partners, our Operation Blessing WASH programs (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) are changing that. We come alongside struggling communities with customized solutions to provide the people living there with reliable access to clean water. Locals also receive valuable education in hygiene and sanitation practices so that they can ensure that their community has access to safe water for years to come.

BRINGING WATER TO THE THIRSTY

PERU – Every morning, Magna and her three children woke up early to begin their daily walk – to get water. During the rainy season, they dug holes in the ground to collect rainwater nearby. But during the dry months, they had to walk three kilometers to obtain water from the nearest spring.

"I remember we used to have to walk far away," said Guido, Magna's 15-year-old son. "Once my mom fell while she was carrying the containers. I didn't like when that kind of stuff happened."

Three hours from the nearest city, the remote community of Pistuni has always been Magna's home. But as a mother, she began to worry about her children growing up in a place where they drank the same water as animals. So many in her community had become "stomach sick" from drinking the water. But a deeper fear gripped her, too. What if the water completely dried up? Magna's husband worked whatever jobs he could to earn enough to feed his family. Their children helped farm potatoes at home to eat. When they had surplus, they sold the extras for additional income. But it wasn't enough to build a bathroom, sink, or shower for their children.

Through your generosity, Operation Blessing reached out to their community with a plan to install a sanitation system with biodigester bathrooms. Together, they laid down pipes where fresh water flowed from the nearest spring straight into common areas near their homes. Magna knew the community's days of gathering water from puddles was coming to an end.

"I don't have to worry for my children getting sick. I'm so happy, our lives have changed forever," said Magna. "Now we can wash our hands and food with clean and safe water."










INTERNATIONAL HUNGER RELIEF FIGHTING POVERTY ONE COMMUNITY AT A TIME

More people are going hungry now than before the pandemic. The World Health Organization reports that global hunger has risen during the past few years to affect as many as 828 million people.* Many simply don't have the income to purchase enough food for their families. Others don't have sustainable methods to raise food themselves.

With your help, Operation Blessing is able to address hunger on both fronts. We come alongside families and communities to implement nutrition programs in schools and develop agricultural programs for entire communities. Then we train individuals in vocational skills and help them establish microenterprises to provide their families with the income they need to support themselves. When needed, we also rebuild and repair homes in some communities, so the residents can focus their limited resources on food and other needs.

INTERNATIONAL HUNGER RELIEF HELPING WOMEN SUPPORT THEIR FAMILIES

Honduras – As a single mother, Carmen does everything she can to support herself and her 8-year-old daughter, Dominic. But that's not easy in the community of San Sebastian, Honduras, where employment opportunities are few – especially for women.

So Carmen and some other women took matters into their own hands. They joined together to form their own business. They baked cakes, sliced bananas, and made *pinol* (a ground mixture of corn, peanuts, cinnamon, pepper, rice, and wheat) to sell. The women didn't know much about baking and had very few utensils to work with, but they made enough income to put food on the table for their families. Then COVID-19 took its toll.

"We had a difficult time," said Carmen. "The business was not working because of the effects of the pandemic."



Between government restrictions and quarantines, the business deteriorated almost to the point of bankruptcy. With no money buy food, Carmen and her daughter sometimes had to ask neighbors or close relatives for something to eat.

Then generous friends of Operation Blessing stepped up to help Carmen and the group of ladies revive their business. Together, we provided an electric mill for the *pinol* and the tools they needed to slice banana and bake cakes.



MEDICAL CARE

YOU BRING HEALING TO THE POOR

For people who are struggling to meet their most basic needs, medical care is a luxury they simply cannot afford. Some live in communities that are so remote, medical care is not even an option. When hurt or sick, they often don't receive the treatment they need, even for minor problems.

Your partnership provides much-needed medical equipment, medicine, supplies, and preventative education to the world's most impoverished communities. Where possible, Operation Blessing trains Community Health Volunteers in first aid and health assessments, so they can provide care to their neighbors and refer patients to regional hospitals when needed.

DISEASE PREVENTION

Operation Blessing donors like you provide preventive care such as eye exams, prenatal ultrasounds, cervical cancer screenings, and vaccines to stop disease before it even begins.

In Honduras, your support helped one community of 500 people develop a natural way to control the mosquito population, by having baby turtles, tilapias and crustaceans feed on mosquito larvae.

With these health programs, the rate of sickness and death is lowered, there are fewer complications during pregnancy, and our beneficiaries become more productive at home, at work, in their schools, and their communities.





CHANGING LIVES THROUGH SURGERY – ONE PERSON AT A TIME

NIGERIA – Damilola is only 8 years old, and life has been difficult for her since the day she was born. She had trouble eating and couldn't speak clearly – all because of a cleft palate.

Her father didn't realize that her condition could be corrected with surgery. "I still thought they would outgrow the condition as children," he said. "I decided to leave it to God."

But Damilola didn't get better with time. As she grew older, her condition made her very prone to infections. To make matters worse, one of Damilola's siblings was also born with the same deformity, a cleft palate.

Then God answered their prayers in a different way. They learned that Damilola could apply for surgery through Operation Blessing.

Her father was skeptical. "I did not believe when she told me it is completely free, that I won't pay a dime for the surgery."

But it was. The cost was completely covered by generous partners who gave through our Life-Changing Surgeries program. They provided Damilola with the surgery she needed to be able to eat properly and speak clearly.

"God has used you to help us," her father said. "May God bless the sponsors wherever they are. They have caused us to smile."

Today, Damilola stands tall with her family and proudly smiles. Her life was completely transformed by the surgery and the compassion of people far away who cared enough about her to give.
