



MORE THAN A MOMENT'S CRISIS

When Hurricane Helene tore through western North Carolina, it destroyed homes, businesses, roads, and city infrastructures. Families and entire communities were left hopeless, mourning lost loved ones—and livelihoods that would take years to rebuild. You responded with much-needed support and hope—not just in the days after the disaster, but you remained to walk beside them for the long journey ahead.

Right after the storm, your compassion joined with local churches to provide resource centers where families could get food, clean water, supplies, hygiene kits, and support. Our hardworking volunteers cleaned up debris and restored homes. Their loving arms wrapped around hurting people like Charles and Maria, whose home was buried under a massive landslide.

This precious couple now has their home back—thanks to you! "You're showing the love of Jesus more than anybody could show it," they told us.

And your heartfelt presence remained in the months that followed to help a hurting community rebuild and heal. After torrential rain from Helene turned a typically dry ravine near Ryan's home into a rushing river, your support helped this family restore their home and property.

"You have come here and taken time away from your family and your life and came to my front yard to help us rebuild," Ryan said. "It's just really encouraging."

Your support did not stop with rebuilding homes but rebuilt the community, as well. After raging floodwaters ripped through the iconic River Arts District of Asheville, many artisans were left without a place to earn their living. Because of your care, Operation Blessing created a temporary 8,000-square-foot workspace large enough to feature 20 artists who will be able to resume their profession and once again support their families.

From the initial response all the way through recovery, you are there—helping those in dire need.

For many families who live in poor or remote communities around the world, the water they drink can be dangerous and even deadly. They risk exposure to waterborne illnesses through contaminated old wells, stagnant ponds, and polluted rivers. But often, they have no other choice.

WATER PROJECTS

Your generosity provides clean water solutions that are tailored specifically to each community. From borehole wells to spring water and rainwater harvesting systems, water is pumped to community access points and stored safely for future use.

CLEAN WATER

MORE THAN A GLASS OF WATER

"I had to walk long distances to get water." Like many of her neighbors, Olga and her son Jose didn't have access to water at their home. They often had to search for sources of water around their community of El Mirador in Honduras. "Many times, when I arrived, there was nothing."

Can you imagine her struggle? Water is a vital resource for everyday life. Without it, her children had nothing to drink, and Olga could not cook or clean. Lack of safe water created a ripple effect into every aspect of their lives—impacting their health, time, and finances.

Like many other remote communities in Honduras, residents of El Mirador struggled with basic sanitation, which posed greater health risks. Without water, they could not dispose of waste properly or even wash their hands.

After our generous partners supplied a new clean water system for the entire community, your love and compassion went a step further and provided 15 new hygiene stations with sinks, showers, and toilets connected to the new clean water supply. Each unit included a concrete floor, pipes to remove waste safely, and a complete handwashing station to promote better hygiene. Both children and adults eagerly participated in WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) training to learn how they could maintain a healthier life and prevent exposure to waterborne diseases.

Your generosity went beyond the gift of clean water. Proper sanitation promotes health and saves families from losing precious time collecting water from unsafe sources.

"Thank you for looking out for our community," Jose said. "We have received a lot of help from Operation Blessing—the latrines, the water project, the school, and the clinic where I received attention—the whole community is grateful."

You have truly given them hope for a brighter, happier life—long into the future!



ORPHAN'S PROMISE NO LONGER "NOBODY KIDS"

Every child should feel wanted and loved. But in the Dominican Republic, children who had emigrated from Haiti were outcasts. Neither government recognized them. They lived in poverty, eating whatever they could find in the local landfill. They became known as "nobody kids."

The love of friends like you reached around these precious children and gave them hope and a future. For the last three years, Orphan's Promise has been providing food for 85 of these children, who now attend Kids for Christ School, ensuring that they receive nutritious meals every day.

"When I visited them in their homes, I found them hungry or oftentimes with food that is not worthy of eating," recalls Elizabeth, school director. The children came to school with stomach pains, skin issues, and headaches. But thanks to your support, they now have a healthier option. "When the children arrive at school, they receive three meals. They have snacks. Their nutrition is more complete, and this really helps their growth."

Our supporters didn't stop there. In addition to nutritious meals and an education, these children are also being fed spiritually. Every day, they learn about Jesus and the Bible through Superbook.


"The Gospel for these children is vital," said Pastor Westor at Kids for Christ School. "Superbook is a tool that helps to make the classroom more dynamic. ... This is what gives them hope."

For children like Donalson, that hope changed everything. "From the day I accepted Jesus Christ, I started to change a lot," Donalson told us. "I always felt that I was poor, that I would never have anything in my life. When I started to talk to God, everything got better."



MORE THAN A MEAL

"I am very lucky to go to a school that cares so much about us."

Esther attends kindergarten at an Operation Blessing preschool in Kimana, Kenya, and has a bright future ahead of her. "I love coming to school and love learning new things every day." You are a part of making that happen!

At one time, young preschoolers like Esther struggled to get enough food and an education. Children as young as 4 years old had to walk up to nine miles just to get to school. The path was dangerous—often slippery, and the area was full of wild animals like elephants. Many children simply didn't start school until they were 10 years old, and those who did start sooner often arrived hungry.

Most families in Kimana lived in such extreme poverty that parents couldn't afford to feed their children. Caring partners like you built a preschool that has served hundreds of students ages 4–8 since 2012. Thanks to your continued support, the school is able to offer the children free hot nutritious meals each day by growing their own beans and vegetables in a garden.

This year, you went a step further and gave them a poultry farm with 50 chickens to provide eggs that would supplement the children's nutritional needs.

"Before the poultry farm, I barely used to eat eggs," Esther said. "The eggs are delicious and make me feel healthy and strong."

Now, the children get eggs about three times a week. Having full stomachs helps them focus so they can learn better. Students are also able to get hands-on experience with the garden and poultry farm so they can gain valuable life skills.

Esther can't contain her smile. "The farm is my favorite part of the school. ... These eggs are super special to me and my friends."



HEALTH & MEDICAL CARE

MORE THAN A CHECKUP

Around the world, millions face the harsh reality of limited or no access to medical care—leaving families and children vulnerable. Without treatment, a simple infection can turn deadly and treatable conditions can lead to lifelong disabilities. Our mobile medical clinics go to some of the hardest to reach, least-served regions—providing valuable healthcare to those who need it most.

Last year, one of our mobile clinics provided free medical checkups, preventative screenings, and much-needed medicine to hurting people in Tondo Manila, Philippines. And together with our partner ministry, Jesus Christ the Restorer Life Church, you also sent them something more—spiritual hope!

Lucia thought she had no one. At 80 years of age, she had survived a stroke but struggled to walk. Many everyday activities like reading became out of reach. Despite her best efforts, Lucia often forgot to take her medicine for high blood pressure. When our mobile medical clinic arrived, she was one of the first in line. Our caring team supported her with medication, vitamins, and reading glasses. Our volunteer doctor connected her memory loss with her stroke and gave her the support she needed.

Vida and her disabled husband, Recolito, also visited the clinic. The couple relied on Vida's income as a manicurist—especially when Recolito could no longer work. But when Vida began experiencing chronic hand numbness and migraines, their very livelihood was threatened. Doctors at the clinic treated them both, offering counseling and the extra support they needed to manage their symptoms and health concerns.

"I didn't know how we would afford healthcare," Vida said. "But today my husband and I were cared for—without spending a single peso." Your love embraced them and reminded her that God had not forgotten them.


